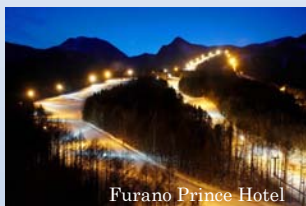
The Naeba Prince Hotel, located in the Niigata

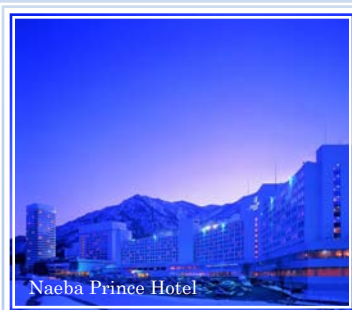
upcoming 2012 FIS Free Style Skiing World Cup. In 2001 the world's longest gondola, Naeba-Tashiro Gondola aka *DragonDola* was built running a distance of 5.5 kilometers (3.4 miles).

Head a little farther north to the island prefecture of Hokkaido, and spend a few days surrounded by the beauty of Furano. The original Furano Prince Hotel was built with 114 rooms. In 1988 the New Furano Prince Hotel opened with 12 stories above ground. Just three years ago, a luxurious hot spring spa facility, Shisai no Yu, opened to provide guests with the perfect winter destination. A favorite with powder enthusiasts and resort skiers alike, the resort has been host to 12 FIS World Cups.

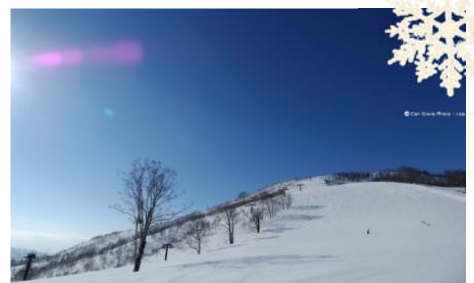

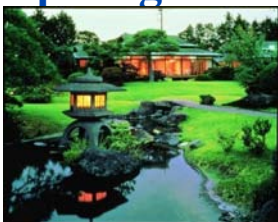

Step outside of your everyday life, leave the stress and worries behind, enter Sanyo-so, feel all the peace and

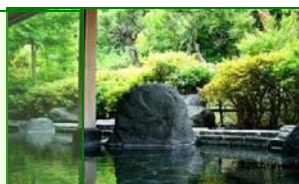
tranquility that only nature herself can provide.

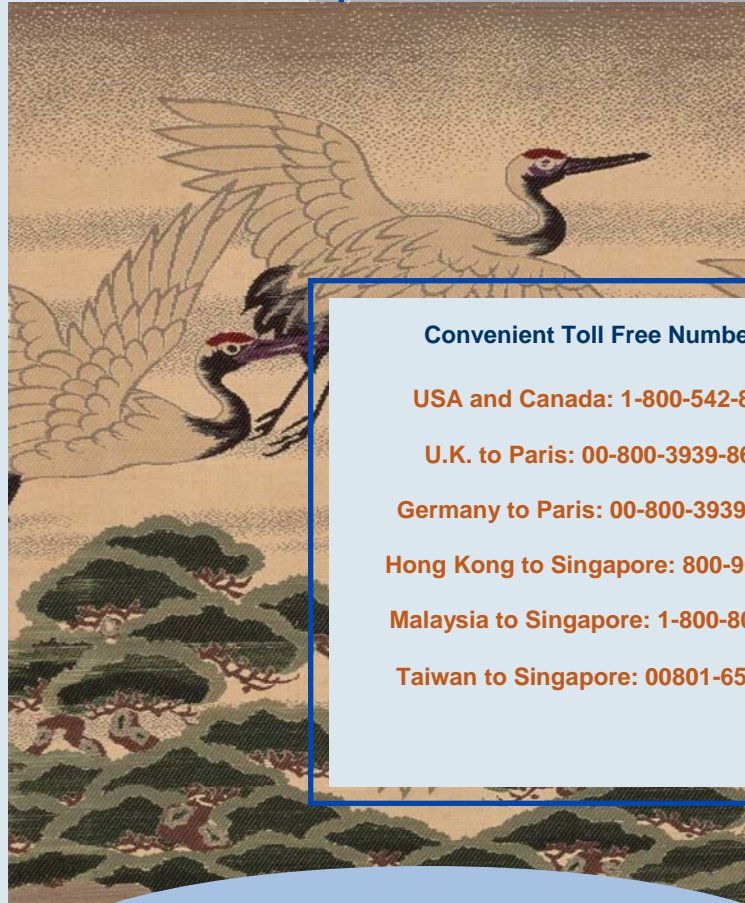
